Dr. David C. He then earned his Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine from Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine in Philadelphia, where he was awarded a United States Air Force scholarship, the William F. He completed his internship and residency at Osteopathic Medical Center in Philadelphia, being elected chief intern and orthopedic resident, while there. As a leader in his field, Dr. Koronkiewicz has given several medical presentations at professional meetings, been published in peer-reviewed publications on various orthopedic topics and completed several continuing education courses. Plus, he's served as a past president of the Indiana Osteopathic Association.
